WHERE THE WILD THINGS ARE

E-safety studies take place each half-term.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....
SCIENCE: We will be learning about different forces and types of rocks. We will be testing, observing, measuring and recording accuracy.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....
GEOGRAPHY: We will learn about the Americas, looking at the physical and human geographical features. With particular attention to the Grand Canyon.

HISTORY: In history we will be looking at this pre-historic unit and learning about the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic, Neolithic eras as well as consider how technology changed across time.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: We will be looking at Christianity, and considering when its people had their beliefs. We will be looking at Buddhism and understanding what it meant by a good life for Buddha.
